

# CARE FARMING TRAINING PROGRAM

Homesteads for Hope Community Farm in Rochester NY is offering (5) paid apprenticeships in our Care Farming Training Program, a 7-month residential experience learning sustainable agriculture while working alongside young adults with disabilities. This position offers hands-on training on an 8-acre vegetable farm, as well as opportunities in flower production, animal husbandry, and CSA logistics. Perks include on-site housing, community engagement, social recreation – and skills to last a lifetime!



#### **The Program Overview**

The CFT Program offered at Homesteads for Hope is a seasonal, 7-month apprenticeship for (5) individuals to learn, work & live on a Care Farm.

## What is Care Farming?



As described by the Care Farming Network: Care Farming is the **therapeutic use of farming practices** for marginalized or vulnerable groups of people. This model is common in the **UK** and Europe and goes by varying names, including Care Farming, Social Farming, and Social Care Farming.

The goal of the Care Farming Network is to have a Care Farm in every County in the U.S.

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## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

#### • What if I've never farmed before?

 First and foremost we are seeking individuals interested in farming who have a demonstrated ability to do physically demanding work, such as landscaping, warehouse jobs, etc.

#### • What if I've never worked with a diverse population?

O We find that when warmhearted people enter our community they discover a deep desire to connect and serve others here; cultivating each person's unique abilities, and supporting each of us as we aspire to a life of dignity, purpose and meaning.

#### • What is the Weekly Schedule?

- The WORK: Monday through Friday, we start the day by
   +/- 8am with program participants and volunteers
   arriving by 9 am and staying until 3 pm. Work expectation is 8 hours/day.
- O The FUN: As an open-to-the-public farm model, we offer a lot of community events in which you will participate throughout the week. Our most popular is our weekly "Thursdays at the Farm" event from 5 to 8 pm.
- Tuesday & Thursdays are the CSA Food Share Pick-up
   Days. CSA members pick up their shares from 3 to 6 pm.
  - There is an off-site CSA Pick-up this year offered in downtown Rochester NY on Tuesdays.

#### • What does the Housing Option include?

- Homesteads for Hope has recently restored a 200 year old farm house which is now a newly renovated 6500SF community center. Inside is the Farmers Residence, a total of 5 bedrooms for the CFTP.
  - Individual bedrooms
  - Fully equipped kitchen
  - Shared living space and dining
  - (2) large bathrooms with walk-in showers
